There seems to be so much disaster and destruction facing our world, I felt that we should seize the opportunity to teach our children how to show compassion, and respond to the desperate plight of our fellow brothers and sisters across the globe in Libya and Morocco.

Christian aid is a charitable organisation that responds to people in need around the world. It reports:-

On Sunday 10 September, Storm Daniel hit Libya. It's feared up to 20,000 people have died after the catastrophic Mediterranean storm burst two dams and flooded the eastern port city of Derna.

More than 5,000 people are known to have died and at least 10,000 are missing after torrents of water and debris swept away entire districts. Bodies are being recovered from the sea.

Storm Daniel has destroyed houses and utility supplies, leaving many areas without any electrical power or water. Families seeking refuge at shelters have lost everything.















Hundreds of homes are buried under mud and debris, and the fear is that many people are also buried in the mud.

People are without the basics such as access to clean water and proper sanitation facilities to prevent the risk of diseases.

Finally, all of you, have unity of mind, sympathy, brotherly love, a tender heart, and a humble mind.

We hope that you will join staff in holding a collection that we can send to Christian Aid appeal towards supporting the people caught up in this terrible disaster.
